Instructions

Permits to install storage tank systems

1. Complete and submit the permit application.
 - A development permit is required if the tank(s) are larger than 10m² (107.6 sq.ft.) in area and 2m (6.5ft.) high.
 - If installing unattended self-serve facilities, please contact Leduc County Fire Services for additional information. Additional security features including but not limited to remote monitoring of video surveillance and intrusion alarm devices on dispenser cabinets, and limits on the quantities of fuel dispensed may be applicable.
2. A Leduc County Fire Services (LCFS), Safety Codes Officer (SCO) will acknowledge receipt of application and contact the applicant if it is apparent the Fire Code is not being followed in the construction planning.
3. Applicant to email fireservices@leduc-county.com a set of PDF electronic drawings or mail to LCFS office two sets of construction drawings stamped by a Professional Engineer licensed to practice in the Province of Alberta.
4. Engineered drawings will be reviewed and if the development is compliant with the National Fire Code (AE) a Plans Review Report will be issued to the applicant.
5. Upon completion of the project a Verification of Compliance (VoC) must be submitted to fireservices@leduc-county.com. A VoC is confirmation that the construction was completed as applied for.
6. The SCO will sign and stamp the VoC and return a copy to the applicant. A final site inspection will be carried out by the SCO within 365 days of permit issuance.

Permits to alter existing storage tank systems

An alteration is a minor change to tank(s) and/or piping (usually in the form of repair) that do not require preparation of engineered drawings. Contact the SCO to see if the project is considered an alteration.

1. Submit a permit application to fireservices@leduc-county.com, accompanied by a description of the scope of work.
2. Application will be reviewed, and if compliant a plans review report will be issued to the applicant.
3. Contractor to submit a verification of compliance (VoC) upon completion of the alteration.
4. The SCO will sign and stamp the VoC and return a copy to the applicant.
5. A SCO will conduct a site inspection within 365 days of permit issuance.

Permits to remove underground storage tank systems

Permits to remove storage tanks apply to underground storage tanks only.

1. Submit a permit application to fireservices@leduc-county.com, accompanied by a description of the scope of work.
2. Application will be reviewed, and if compliant a plans review report will be issued to the applicant.
3. Contractor to submit a tank closure report upon approval.
4. A SCO will conduct a site inspection within 365 days of permit issuance.

5. A permit services report will be issued to the applicant upon completion of the site inspection.
