**A BYLAW TO RESCIND THE CAMROSE COUNTY/LEDUC COUNTY INTERMUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN
BYLAW NO. 06-18.**

WHEREAS

pursuant to Section 631(1) of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, and amendments thereto, enacts that municipalities that have common boundaries and that are not members of a growth region as defined in section 708.01 must, by each passing a bylaw in accordance with this Part or in accordance with sections 12 and 692, adopt an intermunicipal development plan to include those areas of land lying within the boundaries of the municipalities as they consider necessary; and

pursuant to Section 631(2) of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, and amendments thereto, enacts that Section 631(1) does not require municipalities to adopt an intermunicipal development plan with each other if they agree that they do not require one; and

Council of Leduc County passed a motion on September 28, 2021 stating that the Camrose County/Leduc County Intermunicipal Development Plan is no longer required; and

Council of Camrose County agree that the Camrose County/Leduc County Intermunicipal Development Plan is no longer required.

NOW THEREFORE

be it resolved that the council of Leduc County, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That Bylaw 06-18 referred to as the Camrose County/Leduc County IDP attached as "Schedule A" is hereby repealed.
2. This bylaw shall come into effect on December 31, 2021.
