Leduc County has received an application to adopt Bylaw 03-23 The Southern Country Residential Area Structure Plan (SCRASP). The purpose of this plan is to provide the framework for the long-term growth and development of the area while balancing the impact on existing residential development, municipal infrastructure and environmental features, Leduc County is taking the proactive step of guiding development by adopting the SCRASP.
