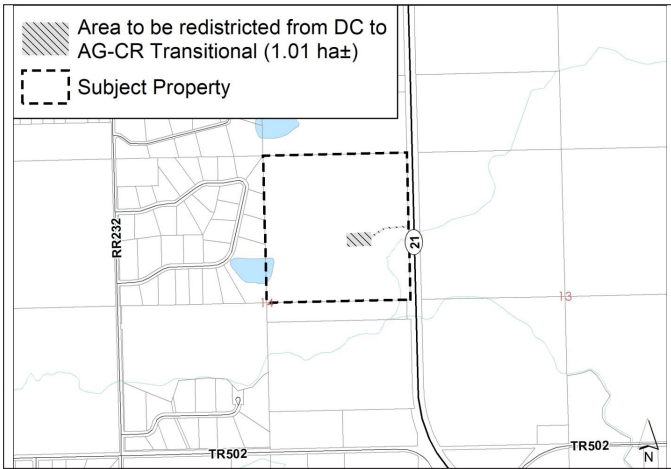


NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Amend Land Use Bylaw 7-08

Application LA22-002 • Tuesday, Sept. 27 at 1:45 p.m.

Leduc County has received an application to amend Land Use Bylaw 7-08. The purpose of the proposed bylaw is to redistrict a 1.01 ha (2.5 ac) parcel of land located in **Pt. NE 14-50-23-W4M** from the **Direct Control (DC-012) District** to the **Agricultural/Country Residential Transitional (AG/CR TR) District**. The purpose of the proposed amendment is to allow for the reclaimed lands to be returned back to an agricultural land use.
