

## Jubilee Park Campground Rules and Regulations

Revised August 2016

*Jubilee Park Campground is nestled on the shores of Wizard Lake. A great family campground with walking trails, a beach, boat launch and concession all within the campground. Our friendly park staff will provide a safe camping experience and assist you however they can. Jubilee Park Campground is owned and operated by Leduc County.*

### Office hours

9 a.m. to 9 p.m. daily; reservations will be taken during these hours only.

### Check in

Starting at 1:30 p.m.; anyone wanting a late check-in must make prior arrangements with the park office.

### Check out

Noon; anyone wanting a late check-out must make prior arrangements with the office and will be charged another day's rental. Parking is available in the overflow area at no cost if guests wish to enjoy the lake for the remainder of their day following check-out.

### Park gates

Entrance gate are closed from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m.

### Refund policy

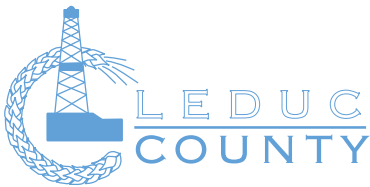
Jubilee Park staff are not authorized to provide refunds for early check-outs. Any request for a refund must be placed with the director for review; park staff will provide instructions.

### Cancellation policy

If a reservation is cancelled with **more than seven days notice** of the arrival date, you will be charged the reservation fee.

If a reservation is cancelled with **less than seven days, but more than 48 hours notice** of the arrival date, you will be charged the reservation fee plus one night's camping fees per site.

If a reservation is cancelled with **less than 48 hours notice** of the arrival date or you do not show up, you will be charged the reservation fee plus two night's camping fees per site.



### **Sites**

All tents and trailers must be registered and paid for prior to set-up. Only one camping unit is permitted on each site. No one under 18 years of age is permitted to reserve a campsite or camp unless accompanied by a parent or guardian. A maximum of two vehicles are permitted per site (site size permitting); extra vehicles/boats and visitors must park in designated parking lots. Under no circumstances are guests permitted to change site numbers without prior office approval.

All sites must be kept clean and tidy at all times.

A picnic table is provided for each site and must remain in the designated site at all times. If a table is moved within a site, it must be moved back to its original location before departing the site.

### **Alcohol**

Alcohol is restricted to the campsite; alcoholic beverages are not permitted in public areas, playgrounds or roadways.

### **Visitors**

Visitors are required to leave the park before 11 p.m.; day-use picnic areas close at 11 p.m.

### **Firewood/fires**

Campfires must be kept small and contained to the provided fire pits, and campfires must be completely extinguished before being left unattended.

Firewood may be purchased at the campground office, or campers can bring their own clean firewood (diseased wood, pallets, pressure treated wood or painted wood is not permitted for burning). The burning of leaves, brush and garbage is not permitted and no garbage is to be left in fire pits.

### **Noise regulations**

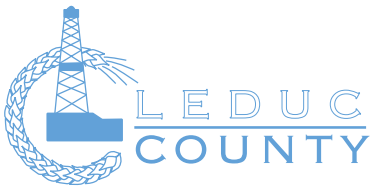
Quiet time is from 11 p.m. to 8 a.m.

All campers have the right to enjoy their campsite in relative peace and quiet, and consideration of neighbours and sleeping children is imperative. Excessive noise such as yelling, loud music and obscene language will not be tolerated. All site holders are responsible for the actions and behaviour of any guests and actions of guests may restrict future visits to the campground.

Power tools may only be used for short periods of time.

Generators may be operated during the following hours only:

- 9 a.m. to 10 a.m.
- 5 p.m. to 7 p.m.
- 9 p.m. to 11 p.m.



### **Pets**

No more than three pets are permitted per site and pets must remain on leash at all times. Handlers must pick up after all pets. Excessive barking will not be permitted.

Pets are not permitted in washrooms or on the beach.

### **Speed limits and safety**

The speed limit within the park is 15 kilometres per hour and caution must be exercised at all times due to the presence of children, pedestrians and other traffic; drivers must be prepared to stop at any time. Vehicles must remain on designated roadways and parking areas only.

ATVs are not permitted to operate within park boundaries.

Safety of all patrons, especially children, is our main concern. Parents/guardians must monitor children at all times for their safety. All children under 18 years of age who operate a bicycle on park property should wear helmets.

### **Fireworks/sparklers**

Fireworks of any kind are not permitted in the campground.

### **Valuables**

Ensure all valuables and coolers are safely stored. Any suspicious activity should be reported to the park office.

**Failure to comply with the above rules may result in eviction. Guests who are evicted from the campground will not receive a refund.**

*Please treat the park with the respect it deserves. Violations such as mistreatment of the park wildlife and willful or careless damage to park property will not be tolerated and criminal charges will be laid. All patrons enter the campground at their own risk; use caution when enjoying Wizard Lake.*
