Did you know?

Here are a few highlights from the last quarter of 2024:

- Two online fruit production workshops attracted 365 registrants. These were hosted by Leduc County Agricultural Services and four municipal partners.
- Around 700 people attended community events, such as the Harvest Festival with Strawberry Hall and Light the Night Winter Luminary.
- More than 680 safety code permits were issued.
- Received **106** development permit applications.
- Co-hosted a Very Merry Thriftmas with more than 400 guests and provided support to several local businesses and vendors.
- Last November, more than 80 people attended the business network breakfast at the Business and Entrepreneur Centre (BEC).

How we helped:

Last October, Leduc County Council approved \$63,000 in grant funding to support community not-for-profits for 2025 events.

- Provided 172 counselling sessions through the subsidy program for 44 people and two families.
- The Senior Assisted Transportation subsidy program registered 45 people. The program provided 67 round trips to 18 individuals.

And for all of 2024, you may find this interesting:

- Issued more than **2,400** permits.
- Opened more than 130 new utility accounts due to the growth in the East Vistas.
- Subsidized housekeeping services assisted 47 households logging 1,391 hours.
- Conducted 1,047 home visits to support caregiver capacity and child development through the Family Resource Network (FRN).
