

Pedestrian safety in the winter

Residents are responsible for maintaining sidewalks adjacent to their property year-round, which includes snow/ice removal in the winter. This is covered under the County's Urban Standards Bylaw (USB).

If you have a concern about snow/ ice on a private sidewalk, please call **780-955-5005**.



For ease of reference, here is Section 12 — Sidewalks from Urban Standards Bylaw 09-24:

- ▶ 12.1 The owner or occupant of a property shall maintain the sidewalks adjacent to their property clear of all snow and ice.
- ▶ 12.2 If an owner fails to comply with section 12.1, the County may arrange to have the sidewalk cleared and the expenses and costs incurred by the County for removing the snow and ice shall be paid upon demand and, if unpaid, may be added to the tax roll of their property.

Beginning March 1, apply for your free burn permit online

Leduc County issues free fire permits to rural residents conducting open burns between March 1 and Oct. 31. Beginning March 1, 2025, residents will be able to apply for these **free** permits using a new online system, located at **lcfs.burnpermits.com.**

The online system allows users to select the type of burn permit they are applying for, such as a permit for a fire smaller than 100 square feet, the location of the burn and a place to upload photos of what will be burned.

Prior to applying for a burn permit online, you will need to create a user account. Full instructions on how to create your account, including a how-to guide, is available at *leduc-county.com/burn-permits*.
