pursuant to Section 708.28(1) and 63(2)(a) of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, and amendments thereto, the Council of Leduc County wishes to repeal the Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework between Camrose County and Leduc County Bylaw 34-18; and

Council of Camrose County passed a motion on January 11, 2022 approving the updated Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework between Camrose County and Leduc County; and

be it resolved that the council of Leduc County, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. That Bylaw 34-18 referred to as the Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework between Camrose County and Leduc County attached as "Schedule A" is hereby repealed.
