## Bylaw No. 19-25

## **Leduc County**

#### A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH THE AGRICULTURAL SERVICE BOARD

#### **WHEREAS**

pursuant to Sections 145 and 146 of the Municipal Government Act (MGA), being Chapter M-26, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, and amendments thereto, the council of Leduc County may pass a bylaw for the establishment and functions of council committees; and

Leduc County is desirous of amending the terms of reference for the Agricultural Service Board and repeal Bylaw No. 08-24

#### **NOW THEREFORE**

be it resolved that the council of Leduc County, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

#### 1. <u>Title</u>

1.1 This bylaw may be cited as the "Agricultural Service Board (ASB)".

#### 2. Membership and Organization

- 2.1 The Board shall consist of seven councillors and two members at large.
- 2.2 All public members are appointed for a two-year term for a maximum of two consecutive terms.
- 2.3 The ASB shall select a chair and vice chair at its first meeting following council's annual organizational meeting.
- 2.4 A quorum shall consist of a least five board members.
- 2.5 The ASB shall follow the rules of order for the conduct of the meetings as established within Leduc County's Council Procedures Bylaw.

#### 3. Meetings

3.1 The committee shall decide at the organizational meeting the date, time and place of regular meetings of the Agricultural Service Board.

## 4. Purpose and Responsibilities

- 3.1 In addition to the duties outlined within the Agricultural Service Board Act, Section 2, the ASB shall:
  - a) act in an advisory capacity to council on matters in accordance with duties, powers and functions outlined within the:
    - i. Weed Control Act
    - ii. Soil Conservation Act
    - iii. Agricultural Pests Act
    - iv. Animal Health Act

- v. Water Act
- b) promote the sound management of surface water (drainage) on agricultural lands giving regard to and in accordance with the budget as adopted by council.

#### 5. Administrative Support

5.1 Clerical and minute taking assistance will be provided by the administrative assistant to the Agricultural Services department.

### 6. <u>Limitations of Power</u>

- 5.1 Pursuant to Section 203 of the MGA, the ASB shall have the same power as council except that the Board does <u>not</u>:
  - a) have the power or duty to pass a bylaw;
  - b) have the power to make, suspend or revoke the appointment of a person to the position of chief administrative officer;
  - c) have the power to adopt budgets under Part 8 of the MGA;
  - d) have the power with respect to taxes under s. 347 of the MGA; and
  - e) have a duty to decide appeals imposed on it by this or another enactment or bylaw, whether generally, or on a case by case basis unless the delegation is to a council committee and authorized by bylaw.

## 7. Repeal and Effective Date

- 7.1 Bylaw No. 08-24 is repealed upon this bylaw coming into force.
- 7.2 This bylaw shall take effect on the date of third reading.

Read a third time with the unanimous consent of the Council Members present and finally passed this 9th day of September, 2025.
