BYLAW NO. 24-19 LEDUC COUNTY

A BYLAW OF LEDUC COUNTY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO ESTABLISH ELECTORAL DIVISION BOUNDARIES.

WHEREAS

pursuant to Section 148 of the *Municipal Government Act*, being Chapter M-26, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, and amendments thereto, a Council may by bylaw in the case of wards established for a municipal district, change the number of wards and their boundaries;

pursuant to Section 148 of the *Municipal Government Act*, a council may state the number of councillors to be elected for each ward established or changed; and

pursuant to Section 149 of the *Municipal Government Act*, this Bylaw must be passed by December 31 of the year before the general election at which it is to take effect;

NOW THEREFORE.

the Council of Leduc County, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1 SHORT TITLE

1.1 This Bylaw may be cited as the "Electoral Boundaries Bylaw".

2 DEFINITIONS

- 2.1 In this Bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires:
 - a) "Division" means "ward" under the Municipal Government Act.

3 DIVISIONS AND DIVISIONAL BOUNDARIES

- 3.1 Leduc County is divided into seven Divisions.
- 3.2 Division boundaries are as set out on in Schedule "A", attached hereto and forming part of this Bylaw.
- 3.3 Division boundaries fall in the centre of roadways or rivers marked as Division boundaries in Schedule "A".
- 3.4 Candidates for the offices of Councillor shall be nominated for a specific Division, and one candidate shall be elected as Councillor for each Division.

4 Repeal

4.1 This Bylaw supersedes any prior bylaws establishing Division boundaries.

5 Enactment

5.1 This Bylaw takes effect for the general municipal election in 2021.
