# Municipal Election, Nomination Deposit BYLAW NO. 19-24

## **Leduc County**

#### A BYLAW REQUIRING A NOMINATION DEPOSIT FOR LEDUC COUNTY MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

#### **WHEREAS**

pursuant to the *Municipal Government Act (MGA)*, Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, and amendments thereto, Leduc County may pass bylaws; and

pursuant to section 30(1) of the Local Authorities Election Act (LAEA), Chapter L-21 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, and amendments thereto, and section (16) of the Municipal Affairs Statutes Amendment Act, Leduc County may pass a bylaw to provide for the method of payment for a nomination deposit by a candidate for Leduc County municipal elections;

### **NOW THEREFORE**

be it resolved that the council of Leduc County, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. That every nomination be accompanied by a deposit in the amount of \$100.00 payable in cash, by certified cheque, money order, e-transfer, debit card or credit card;
- 2. Bylaw No. 03-21 is rescinded upon this bylaw coming into force;
- 3. This bylaw comes into force and effect upon third and final reading.

Read a second time this 12<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2024.

Read a third time with the unanimous consent of the Council Members present and finally passed this 12<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2024.
