## **BY-LAW NO. 28-04**

## A BY-LAW OF LEDUC COUNTY TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 30-02 AUTHORIZING BORROWING FROM THE ALBERTA CAPITAL FINANCE AUTHORITY FOR THE HAMLET OF LOOMA WASTEWATER COLLECTION AND TREATMENT SYSTEM

WHEREAS borrowing by-laws must be valid as defined in section 273 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000 and amendments thereto,

WHEREAS the Alberta Capital Finance Authority (Formerly Alberta Municipal Financing Corporation) have determined that borrowing by-laws must allow for semi-annual repayment terms;

WHEREAS Leduc County Council deems it to be in the public interest to amend By-law No. 30-02 Authorizing Borrowing from the Alberta Capital Finance Authority for the Hamlet of Looma;

NOW THEREFORE,: UNDER AND BY VIRTUE of the power conferred upon it by the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000 and amendments thereto, the Council of Leduc County enacts that By-Law No. 30-02 be amended as follows:

- 1. Through out the by-law where ever the name Alberta Municipal Financing Corporation is stated it be replaced by the new name Alberta Capital Finance Authority,
- 2. Page one, sixth paragraph replace the words "annual installments" with the words "semi-annual or annual equal payments",
- 3. Page one, sixth paragraph replace the words "per annum, payable annually" with the words "per annum or semi-annum, payable semi-annually or annually",
- 4. Page one, last paragraph replace the words "calculated per annum and payable annually" with the words "calculated per annum or semi-annum and payable semi-annually or annually",
