Public presentation

West Central Forage Association - virtual presentation via TEAMS

Becky Doherty, General Manager, West Central Forage Association provided a presentation about the West Central Forage Association (WCFA) organization and programs:

- Non-profit organization providing support to forage and livestock producers in the region through extension work and applied research since 1978
- WCFA works in cooperation with a number of provincial and federal government agencies, local industry and six local municipalities: Brazeau, Lac Ste Anne, Leduc, Parkland, Woodlands, and Yellowhead counties

- Three small plot research sites: hemp variety trials, regional silage trials, perennial forage trials
- Current projects include: sire-progeny links in multi-sire commercial herds; soil moisture probes in forage systems, soil revitalization, soil health benchmark monitoring
- Biological control agent program: Canada thistle stem-gall fly and Canada thistle stem-mining weevil
- Large network of partnerships
- Seven members on the Board of Directors; annual general meeting typically scheduled for mid-March
- Website enhancements planned for 2022 with member portal including expanding links for presentations and testimonials
- Specialist on-call service provides referrals for producers

Responding to a board member inquiry about hemp trials Ms. Doherty provided comments about a project under development for a future large scale plot utilizing equipment that typical crop producers would have available to them, as well as developing producer information about potential markets for hemp fibre and seed.

The opportunity to access non-potable water in that area has generated a great deal of local resident interest and over 46 access applications have been received to date. Most users will be utilizing the non-potable water for livestock and seasonal use for watering gardens and shelterbelt plantings.
