



Clubroot report

Manager of Agricultural Services Aaron Van Beers presented the staff report with regard to 2022 crop inspections of canola for the presence of clubroot disease. In response to questions by board members, the following information was provided:

- Of the positive fields that had been confirmed positive in the past, the majority of those fields were found to be at low levels of severity. Most crop producers are doing a good job of managing clubroot and are mindful of the importance of planning resistant variety rotations
- Growing conditions were dry at seeding, wet early season, then very dry for the remainder of the
 growing season the wet period may have favoured the development of clubroot and followed by very
 dry conditions may have lessened the potential severity of the infestation
- Any activities that result in soil movement, such as power harrowing, has the potential to increase risk of spreading spores throughout the field and some crops, such as potatoes, require more soil disturbance
