- Pre-cleaner machine will be \$65,000 for just the machine, for a total of \$120,000 with all in related expenses; looking to do this over 2 years (dust collection system 2025, pre-cleaner machine 2026)
- They wanted to inquire if Leduc County and Brazeau County can financially assist these upgrades
- There is a need to stay on top of upgrades and maintenance to keep it viable within 20 years
- Member Doblanko reminded Mr. Scheetz that the request needs to be within the budget year; 2025 has already been set, so the request would need to be for 2026 budget.
