 - o Identify the annual priorities for the County and advise how Victim Services Unit can help to achieve the County's vision.
 - o Advise if there are initiatives/events that require Victim Services participation.
 - o Encourage residents and partners in the community to support Victim Services. Assist with promotion of services provided by the Victim Services Unit e.g. County publications.
 - o Request financial support with an increase of current funding by 15% for 2018.
