Order and Roll Call

Grant Bain, Director of Planning & Development, provided an update on the activities of the Edmonton Metropolitan Region Board.

Public Hearing - Proposed Changes to Electoral Boundaries

Mayor Doblanko convened the Public Hearing at 1:46 p.m. with respect to the proposed changes to electoral boundaries of Leduc County.

Mayor Doblanko called upon Administration staff to provide background information.

Deputy County Manager Rick Thomas provided a staff report with respect to Leduc County electoral divisions/wards, highlighting the following:

- 1) Leduc County has spent considerable time reviewing their electoral divisions in keeping within plus/minus 25% of the average population. As of 2016, Federal Census Leduc County's official population was 13,780; with the Beaumont and Edmonton annexation, Leduc County's population is estimated at 13,172. The average population per electoral division is calculated as 13,172 divided by 7 = 1,882.
- 2) The dissolution of the Village of New Sarepta in 2010 has significantly increased the population of Division 1 whereby the division is currently experiencing +61% of the average population for a Leduc County division, followed by +53% of the average in Division 2.
- 3) Leduc County held six workshops, open to the public since 2018. Council developed and reviewed six different scenarios as well as considering the current electoral boundary. Individual Councillors provided preferences for scenarios and Council as a whole agreed to the recommended scenario for the proposed new electoral division/ward boundaries for Leduc County.
- 4) Advertisement of the proposed bylaw and public hearing occurred in the August 23rd and 30th editions of the Leduc Representative. Further, Leduc County Policy CC-01 Public Participation states that a public hearing is a method that may be used for consultative decisions.
- 5) There were two phone calls for clarification received and no written submissions received.



Mayor Doblanko asked if council members had any questions for administration.

In response to questions by council members, the following clarification was provided:

The population count for each division would be as follows:

Division 1 - 2579

Division 2 - 2488

Division 3 - 2331

Division 4 – 1371

Division 5 - 1719

Division 6 - 1345

Division 7 – 1339

➤ There were no adjustments made in 2010 with the dissolution of New Sarepta. In 2013, Council reviewed the population and were satisfied the boundaries did not need adjustment.

Mayor Doblanko asked if there was any other correspondence received, and there was none.

Mayor Doblanko called upon anyone in attendance to speak to proposed electoral divisions/wards, and there was no one.

Mayor Doblanko asked if there were any further questions, and there were none.
