2018 Final Budget Adjustments

Mrs. Natasha Wice, Director of Finance, provided a staff recommendation to approve amendments to the 2018 Final Budget Operating Fund.

440-18 Councilor Wanchuk – that Leduc County Council approves the following amendments to the 2018 Final Budget Operating Fund as follows:

- 1) Water:
 - a. Sales of Goods and Services (1-400) was \$2,041,264 and should be \$2,063,893;
 - b. Purchases from other local government (2-300) was \$948,366 and should be \$968,745; and
 - c. Other revenues (1-900) was \$269,073 and should be \$266,823.
- 2) Sewer:
 - a. Other revenues (1-900) was \$433,534 and should be \$435,784.
- 3) Public Works & Waste Management:
 - a. Other revenues (1-900) and Major Projects Operating Expenses reduce Public Works and increase Waste Management by \$627,986.
