

Request Adjustment of Property Taxes due to Fire - Tax Roll #1280031

Manager of Assessment Services Karen Burnand presented a staff report with respect to a request by the landowner of Tax Roll #1280031 for adjustment of property taxes due to a fire that occurred in 2019.

05-20 Councillor Wanchuk -- that Leduc County council approves the following recommendation by administration with respect to a fire that destroyed a residence in 2019 located on Tax Roll #1280031:

- taxes for the destroyed improvement be prorated for the time it was intact prior to the fire;
- no change would be made to the land taxes or those buildings not destroyed by the fire;
- prorated calculations of the destroyed residence for the refunded portion of the 2019 property taxes is \$1,512.68.
