Agricultural Services Department Activity Report

Agricultural Services administration staff highlighted points in the department activity report:

- Health Canada Pest Management Regulatory Agency announcement of their decision to cancel registration of 2% liquid strychnine concentrate (LSC) product for the control of Richardson's ground squirrels. Sales of 2% LSC will end on March 4, 2022 and the last date that the product can be legally used by agricultural producers is March 4, 2023.
- Under the Canadian Agricultural Partnership New Efficient Grain Dryer program;
 a current Environmental Farm Plan (EFP) is required for funding and that requirement has prompted renewed interest in completing/updating EFP.
- Rahr Malting is using the EFP as part of their sustainable sourcing program and all of the producers must have a current EFP.
- Before the Plate event 33 enthusiastic registrants in attendance and planning is underway for future discussion and collaboration.
- Letter from Minister of Agriculture and Forestry referencing support of the removal *F. graminearum* from the Pest + Nuisance Control Regulation.
- Agricultural Services & Road Operations road right-of-way maintenance activities coordination: It has been a prolific brushing season and discussions are underway regarding the coordination for follow up spraying during the growing season.
- Whitemud/Blackmud Creeks Water Act approval for maintenance activities Ensures pre-development release rates are adhered to by all contributing municipalities under "fenceline approval". Will serve to lessen impact on the local watershed.

<u>Alberta Agriculture + Forestry – Key Contact Verbal Report</u>

Trevor Wallace, Alberta Agriculture and Forestry Key Contact, Nutrient Management Specialist provided comments on the following points:

 Fusarium on the Pest + Nuisance Control Regulation – Consensus was heard from a round table discussion of a few years ago regarding removal of *F. graminearum*. However, since that time concerns have been raised that all interests weren't involved in the discussion.

Leduc County A.S.B. March 9, 2020 - 11 -

- Farmer-led Research Received comments from over 1400 participants. Farmer-led focus to ensure that research initiatives are consistent with what producers need/desire.
- Canadian Centre for Food Integrity: Attended a recent presentation which provided interesting statistics reporting current areas of consumer concerns and trending attitudes. A summary will be provided to Board members at a later date.
- Alberta Milk has initiated their "proAction" on-farm food safety program which focuses on food safety assurance on farm. Program utilizes on-farm verifiers.

Clubroot Status Report

Aaron Van Beers, Manager of Agricultural Services presented his report:

- Presentation at the Alberta Canola Producers workshop in Grande Prairie, providing perspective on the municipal side of the experience and participated in a question and answer period.
- Confirmation that some currently available seed varieties are showing 3D resistance although there has also been some concerns about variety resistance purity reported by the Canola Council of Canada.
- Have just been notified that the latest application for funding for the University of Alberta research and laboratory pathotype testing has not been successful. This is was the second submission for funding that has been refused. The U of A may need to go to a fee for service for pathotype testing, if continued. Plans for a meeting with U of A researchers later in the week to discuss the situation.

City of Edmonton Mosquito Abatement Program

Notification has been received from the City of Edmonton regarding their annual mosquito monitoring and control program:

- Requesting permission to perform larval control efforts on Leduc County owned lands within a limited buffer zone adjacent to City of Edmonton boundaries.
- The City of Edmonton will make requests for permission for access and treatment on private property directly to landowners.

Leduc County A.S.B. March 9, 2020 - 12 -

• Since 2014, Leduc County has provided permission conditional upon limiting product use to *Bacillus thuringiensis israelensis* only.

019-2020 Board Member Scobie – that administration respond to the City of Edmonton granting permission to conduct their 2020 mosquito monitoring and control program activities on Leduc County owned, operated, or leased lands utilizing products containing *Bacillus thuringiensis israelensis* only.
