<u>Dust Suppression Comparison Review</u>

Mr. Stone presented the review of the products and areas that are going to be trialed.

Committee Member Belozer, commented that review with Brazeau County indicates their trials have been good but have not had a full year review yet.

Lorne Reed – crude oil was used over many years until environmental impacts led to more refined products becoming more common.

Mr. Stone spoke to the changes in the Continuous Dust Control program following annexation. The number of roads has decreased significantly, and so Public Works could consider a different product on these roads.

DL 1040 can be a surface product with a light mix with the grader that can provide a longer application and residual tends to build up in the road and may last longer.

Mr. Reed talked about the canola product and how it works and availability.

Discussion about asphalt millings and products available to help bind that application.
