# Request to Permit Undeveloped Road Allowance, Range Road 240 – Bryce Bernhard Re: 190-19

Mr. Bryce Bernhard addressed the committee to indicate that if they wanted to share the ROW for grazing they could have a texas gate, however, his intent is to have a gate that could be accessed by the neighboring properties, rather than traffic travelling south down the private road and having to turn around.

Moses Hofer and Kerri Hofer addressed the Committee through the letter that was distributed prior to the meeting. Historically, they have been grazing this portion without a lease, and now they would be responsible for fencing to their property line. In addition that if they should decide to subdivide in the future, they understood that the permit could be revoked and that they would be required at that time to build the road to Leduc County standards to service the subdivision.

Mr. Ed Reirson addressed the Committee with concerns from his letter which was distributed prior to the meeting. He noted that the fence on the west side of the Right of Way is poor and would need to be upgraded. He felt that the right of way is not a good piece of property for grazing as it accommodates traffic. His understanding was according to the general conditions, that road leasing was only for grazing or cropping purposes. He has concerns about public traffic using this right of way.

O06-20 Committee Member Smith -- that the Public Works Committee commences the process to permit the undeveloped Road Allowance 400m South of Highway 623 to allow for driveway access to Mr. Bernhard's property.
