Public Works Committee By-law 16-18

031-20 Committee Member Doblanko -- that the Public Works Committee approve the recommended changes to the Public Works Committee Terms of Reference bylaw and refer to Leduc County Council for first, second and third reading.

Road Bans

Inquiries were made at the water haulers meeting held on March 6, 2020, about getting exemptions to road bans for hauling water in and sewer out of banned subdivisions.

Haulers had made the request to haul a certain percentage above the ban, in order to make it more affordable for the residents. It was determined that more investigation would be necessary.

Discussion held about what the risks of damage to infrastructure could be, and what would the further investigation would entail.

Further thoughts could be that there may be some consideration if during the summer months there may be less risk of damage, but not in spring road conditions.

Analysis would need to be done about whether risk of damage for more loads at a lower axle weight would equal the same as less loads at higher weights.

Permitting would be of value to control who is accessing and how many are moving.

Water Haulers Meeting Update

Discussion about the processes, concerns, safety and cleanliness of the facilities.

Request was made to discuss the pricing as it was higher than surrounding municipalities.

Understanding of how they chose to determine cost of business.

They indicated that Leduc County would have an increase in revenue if we could address some of the cost, safety and environmental issues.

Request for fan out of information before water bans come into place, and water outlets are affected.

Leduc County will complete a multi-year cost/usage analysis of the facility for the existing user set.
