Order and Roll Call

Agenda Adoption

01-18 Committee Member Belozer -- that the Agenda for the January 16, 2018 Subdivision Authority meeting be adopted as circulated.

Proposed Subdivision Pt. NW 1/4 28-50-23-W4

Mrs. Charlene Haverland, Manager, Development Services presented a staff report with respect to the application by applicants/landowners Manpreet Baraich, Raupreet Sandhu, and Gurpreet Sandhu. Staff recommends that this subdivision application be deferred until March 20, 2018 in order to allow administration to meet with Alberta Transportation to discuss the requirements.

Update

This application was presented to the Subdivision authority on December 19, 2017 at which time the decision was deferred in order for the applicant to reduce the size of the proposed parcel. In that time, it was discovered the subdivision application had not been referred to Alberta Transportation as per the requirements of the newly updated Municipal Government Act. Upon referral of the application, Alberta Transportation responded that in order to approve Subdivision Authority varying the requirements of Section 14 of the Subdivision and Development Regulation for the proposed subdivision, the intersection at Range Road 234 and Highway 625 would require improvements.

Chair Doblanko asked Committee Members if they had any questions for the technical staff.



In response to questions from Committee Members, Mrs. Haverland, provided the following:

- Even if a deferral is approved today, administration feel Alberta Transportation will likely not agree to a meeting.
- If the application is approved today, Alberta Transportation will appeal it and then it will go before the Municipal Government Board (MGB); Administration would then ask the MGB to approve the subdivision as approved by the Subdivision Authority.
- The Municipal Government Act changed October 31, 2017 from 0.8 to 1.8 km for Alberta Transportation referrals.
- Alberta Transportation is asking the applicant to make improvements at Range Road 234 and Highway 625
- A meeting with Alberta Transportation would help the County in making future decisions regarding subdivisions.
- The County needs to understand the where the threshold is for the number of subdivisions in the area.

Chair Doblanko asked Committee Members if they had any further questions for technical staff, and there were none.

03-18 Committee Member Belozer -- that the application by Manpreet Baraich, Raupreet Sandhu and Gurpreet Sandhu to subdivide a developed 5.50 ha± (13.50 ac±) parcel for country residential use from a title area of 32.37 ha± (80.00 ac±) be deferred to the April 17, 2018 meeting at 1:30 p.m., in order for administration to meet with Alberta Transportation to discuss the requirements of Section 14 of the Subdivision and Development Regulation for the proposed subdivision.
