I/We, the undersigned, hereby make application for an **incorporated dust suppression** strip to be applied by the Leduc County Public Works and Engineering Department to the municipal roadway adjacent to my/our farmstead (residence) at the location described.

Incorporated dust suppression strips shall be applied to the identified road surface by the contractor after completion of this application form by the Resident / Landowner and the prepayment of the calculated fee. Scheduling of the work shall be subject to regular dust suppression program priorities and shall be combined with other requests in the same geographical area to maximize cost effectiveness. **Application and payment must be received by May 5, 2019. No applications will be accepted after this deadline.**

- Incorporated dust suppression** strips shall be a minimum length of 122 meters (400 feet) and a maximum length of 366 meters (1200 feet) of roadway surface. Requests for incorporated dust suppression strips greater than 122 meters (400 feet) of roadway surface shall be subject to the discretion of the Director, Public Works and Engineering or his designate. All **incorporated dust suppression strips** registered and paid for by residents are warranted to suppress dust for one (1) year from the day of installation.
- Leduc County will subsidize \$618.35 for the initial 122 meters. Accordingly, a fee of **\$2,945.27 plus GST**, will be charged, plus a fee of \$29.21 per meter plus GST for each meter thereafter, up to a maximum total of 366 meters. Additions to existing dust control will be subject to a \$29.21 per meter plus GST charge. Dust suppression strips for businesses or for businesses paying for residential strips will be charged \$29.21 per meter plus GST.

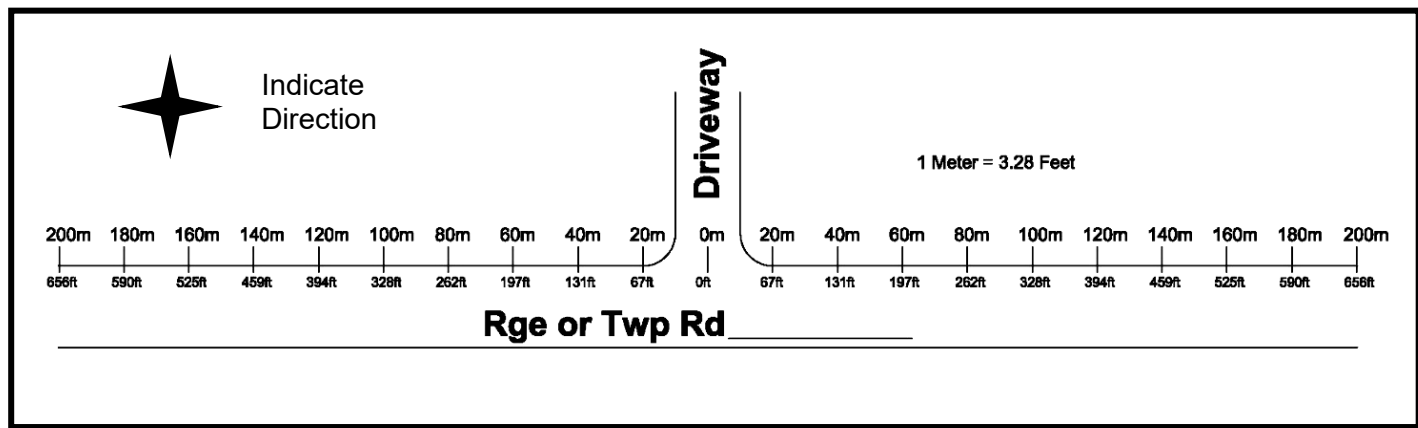

Indicate, on the sketch above, where you want the incorporated dust suppression strip located. To ensure the correct placement of the dust control product, **stakes should be placed** at the side of the road, identifying the start and end of the strip, otherwise the sketch above will be used as the correct location in the event of a discrepancy.

The **incorporated dust suppression product used is only a temporary** solution to the dust problem and is intended to be effective for one (1) year from the day of installation.

It is imperative that regular maintenance work continue to preserve the road base in a smooth and safe condition for the traveling public. Accordingly, maintenance of the treated portion of the road will be consistent with other County roads. A grader will be used to level and fill in ruts, washboard or potholes when required. Typically, all gravel roads will be re-graveled every 2 – 4 years. Therefore, the dust control strip may be graveled over during the regular program to ensure safety and integrity of the road surface; however, the site will be assessed prior to gravelling.

Warranty Request: If you feel that the dust suppression strip is no longer suppressing dust, please contact Public Works and Engineering at 780.979.6185 to request reassessment, subject to the discretion of the Director, Public Works and Engineering or his designate.

It must be stressed that Leduc County retains full ownership of and responsibility for the maintenance of roads under Leduc County jurisdiction. Your contribution to the incorporated dust suppression strip in no way constitutes a permanent right of any kind.
