Conditions

Act – The issuance of a permit shall not prevent an electrical safety codes officer from issuing a correction notice if an electrical installation or part thereof is found not to be in accordance with the *Safety Codes Act*, regulations and bylaws.

Deviation – No deviation from plans, specifications or information contained on the application for this permit shall be permitted without prior written authorization from the electrical safety codes officer.

Expiry – This permit expires Dec. 31, 2020, regardless of date of issue.

Safety codes officer – The person authorized to perform installations governed by this permit shall notify the electrical safety codes officer prior to concealment of any portion of the installation.

Excavation – Before excavation is started, check for the location of utilities.

Inspection – The Electrical Safety Codes Officer shall not be refused admission during any reasonable hour of the day for the purpose of conducting an inspection.

Final inspection – Upon completion of all the work authorized by this permit, the electrical safety codes officer shall be notified that all work is completed and ready for final inspection.

Important notice

If any portion or part of the work is concealed prior to an approval by an electrical safety codes officer all work may be requested to be uncovered.

Any required re-inspection shall be subject to a re-inspection fee, as per current fee schedule. This fee is required to be paid prior to the re-inspection taking place.

Any person who commits a breach of any of the provisions of the *Safety Codes Act*, or Regulations made pursuant thereto, or of the conditions of a permit is guilty of an offense under the Act.

Annual permits – Where an annual electrical permit has been issued, minor repairs may be executed on the premises identified as the establishment in an annual permit during the time specified. A single annual permit may be issued to cover all minor repairs performed during a full calendar year or for a lesser period of time when required, but the permit fee shall be based on a full calendar year.

The person responsible for an annual permit shall ensure the work executed under the permit is performed by properly certified personnel, whether an employee of the establishment or contracted personnel.

An annual permit may be cancelled by the electrical safety codes officer if it is determined that electrical work is not being performed in a responsible manner.

An annual permit does not entitle the holder to effect major electrical alterations in, or additions to the establishment.

The holder of an annual permit may obtain a permit for major electrical alterations in or additions to the establishment if he first submits plans and specifications for examination.

The electrical safety codes officer shall determine the number of inspections to be made on an establishment for which an annual permit has been issued.

The holder of an annual permit shall maintain in the establishment a current and accurate two year record of all minor repairs and shall make it available to the electrical inspector on request.
