

BYLAW NO. 07-20

LEDUC COUNTY

A BYLAW OF LEDUC COUNTY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO RESCIND THE TOWN OF BEAUMONT AND LEDUC COUNTY INTERMUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN BYLAW NO. 33-98.

WHEREAS

the council of Leduc County deems it to be in the public interest to rescind the Town of Beaumont and Leduc County Intermunicipal Development Plan Bylaw No. 33-98;

AND WHEREAS

pursuant to Section 631 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26, Statutes of Alberta and amendments thereto, the council of Leduc County adopted Bylaw No. 33-98 Intermunicipal Development Plan;

NOW THEREFORE, the council of Leduc County, duly assembled, enact as follows:

1. That Bylaw No. 33-98 known as the Town of Beaumont and Leduc County Intermunicipal Development Plan attached as "Schedule A" is hereby rescinded.
2. This bylaw shall take effect on the date of the third reading.
