

Counting Specific Ballot Boxes - Municipal Election

BYLAW NO. 08-21

LEDUC COUNTY

A BYLAW ESTABLISHING COUNTING OF SPECIFIC (SPECIAL BALLOT, ADVANCE VOTE AND INSTITUTIONAL VOTE) BALLOT BOXES FOR THE LEDUC COUNTY MUNICIPAL AND SCHOOL ELECTIONS.

WHEREAS

pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, and amendments thereto, Leduc County may pass bylaws; and

pursuant to Section 85.1(4) of the Local Authorities Election Act (LAEA), Chapter L-21 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, and amendments thereto, Leduc County may pass a bylaw allowing the returning officer to count specific (special ballot, advance vote and institutional vote) ballot boxes prior to closing of voting hour on election day.

NOW THEREFORE

be it resolved that the council of Leduc County, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

- (1) That the returning officer of Leduc County may count the special ballot box, advance vote ballot box and institutional vote ballot box no earlier than 7:30 p.m. on election day.
- (2) This bylaw comes into force and effect upon receiving third and final reading.

Read a first time this 23rd day of March, A.D. 2021.

Read a second time this 23rd day of March, A.D. 2021.

Read a third time with the unanimous consent of the council members present and finally passed this 23rd day of March, A.D. 2021.
