## Counting Specific Ballot Boxes - Municipal Election BYLAW NO. 08-21

## LEDUC COUNTY

A BYLAW ESTABLISHING COUNTING OF SPECIFIC (SPECIAL BALLOT, ADVANCE VOTE AND INSTITUTIONAL VOTE) BALLOT BOXES FOR THE LEDUC COUNTY MUNICIPAL AND SCHOOL ELECTIONS.

## **WHEREAS**

pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, and amendments thereto, Leduc County may pass bylaws; and

pursuant to Section 85.1(4) of the Local Authorities Election Act (LAEA), Chapter L-21 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, and amendments thereto, Leduc County may pass a bylaw allowing the returning officer to count specific (special ballot, advance vote and institutional vote) ballot boxes prior to closing of voting hour on election day.

## **NOW THEREFORE**

be it resolved that the council of Leduc County, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

- (1) That the returning officer of Leduc County may count the special ballot box, advance vote ballot box and institutional vote ballot box no earlier than 7:30 p.m. on election day.
- (2) This bylaw comes into force and effect upon receiving third and final reading.

Read a second time this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of March, A.D. 2021.

Read a third time with the unanimous consent of the council members present and finally passed this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of March, A.D. 2021.
