

BYLAW NO. 33-11

LEDUC COUNTY

A BYLAW OF LEDUC COUNTY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE LEDUC COUNTY LIBRARY BOARD AND RESCIND BYLAW NO. 8-11.

WHEREAS

the Council of Leduc County deems it expedient to propose the establishment of a Municipal Library Board.

NOW THEREFORE,


With the authority and under the provisions of Part 1 of the "*Libraries Act*", being Chapter L-11, the Council of Leduc County duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. There shall be established a Municipal Library Board for the Leduc County.
2. The Municipal Library Board shall manage, regulate and control municipal library services.
3. The policies of the Municipal Library Board shall be governed by Parts 1 and 5 of the "*Libraries Act*" and Amendments and Regulations pertaining thereto.
4. Membership
The Leduc County Library Board shall consist of eight (8) members including:
 - i) Two (2) members of Council; and
 - ii) Six (6) members who reside within Leduc County.
5. Appointment of Members
 - i) The members of Leduc County Library Board shall be appointed by Council for one, two or three (3) year terms.
 - ii) Membership terms shall be set up so that terms will expire alternatively amongst the membership.
6. This Bylaw shall take effect on the date of the third reading

Read a third time with the unanimous consent of Council Members present and finally passed this 27th day of September, A.D., 2011.
