A BYLAW TO REPEAL THE INTERMUNICIPAL COLLABORATION FRAMEWORK BETWEEN CAMROSE COUNTY AND LEDUC COUNTY BYLAW NO. 34-18.

WHEREAS

pursuant to Section 708.28(1) and 63(2)(a) of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, and amendments thereto, the Council of Leduc County wishes to repeal the Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework between Camrose County and Leduc County Bylaw 34-18; and

Council of Camrose County passed a motion on January 11, 2022 approving the updated Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework between Camrose County and Leduc County; and

NOW THEREFORE

be it resolved that the council of Leduc County, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That Bylaw 34-18 referred to as the Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework between Camrose County and Leduc County attached as "Schedule A" is hereby repealed.
2. This bylaw shall come into effect on the 12th day of April, A.D. 2022.

Read a third time and finally passed this 12th day of April, A.D. 2022.
