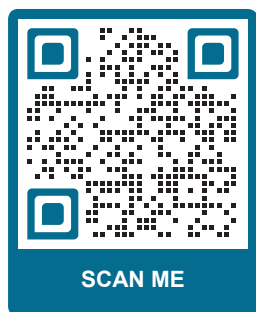
Preparing twine for recycling

Pick up **free** twine collection bags from any Leduc County transfer station (view locations online at www.leduc-county.com/transfer-stations) to participate in a pilot twine recycling program. Take the following steps to prepare your twine for recycling:

1. Shake to remove debris, snow or ice.
2. Place loose twine in a collection bag.
Plastic twine only. Bags of twine mixed with netting, sisal twine or other materials will be rejected.
3. Return full bags to the **New Sarepta** or **Sunnybrook** transfer stations.
