

AMEND THE LEDUC COUNTY LAND USE BYLAW 7-08

BYLAW NO. 02-23

LEDUC COUNTY

A BYLAW FOR LEDUC COUNTY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AMEND THE LEDUC COUNTY LAND USE BYLAW NO. 7-08.

WHEREAS

Pursuant to Sections 191 and 640 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, and amendments thereto, the Council of Leduc County deems it to be in the public interest to amend the Leduc County Land Use Bylaw No. 7-08;

NOW THEREFORE

Be it resolved that the Council of Leduc County, duly assembled, enacts that Bylaw No. 7-08 be amended as follows:

1. That the following use be removed from Part 9.1.3 Discretionary Uses of the Ag – Agricultural Land Use District and Part 9.2.3 Discretionary Uses of AG/CR TR – Agricultural/Country Residential Transitional District:

Rural Wedding and Agricultural Event Facility

2. That the following regulation be added to Part 9.1 Agricultural District:

9.1.8 Rural Wedding and Agricultural Event Facility

- a) Rural Wedding and Agricultural Event Facilities shall be considered a discretionary use that may be located only on the following parcels :

Plan 0921138, Block 1, Lot 1

Plan 0624674, Block 1, Lot 1

Plan 1624256, Block 1, Lot 1

3. This bylaw shall take effect on the date of third reading.

Read a first time this 14th day of February, A.D. 2023.

Read a second time this 14th day of February, A.D. 2023.

Read a third time with the unanimous consent of the Council Members present and finally passed this 14th day of February, A.D. 2023.
